Recycling Textiles in Somerset County

Effective Oct. 1, 2008, textiles will no longer be collected with curbside recycling in Somerset County. However, residents may drop off clean, dry textiles at the county Recycling Center, located at 40 Polhemus Lane, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. as part of the First Saturday of the Month program. The next drop-off will be held Saturday, Sept. 6.

The types of textiles that will be accepted at the Recycling Center remain the same: clean, dry clothing, drapes, curtains, sheets, towels, belts, handbags, clean cloth, shoes (pairs) and small stuffed animals.
