*Skills Assessments for ages 7 thru 11 (must be 12 on or before April 30, 2016) will take place at the Franklin Middle School gym on Saturday January 16 and 23rd from 4 pm – 7 pm Only fully registered/paid baseball players may evaluate; girls' softball players do not need not evaluate!

The skill assessment evaluation involves hitting, throwing and fielding. Players should arrive with baseball glove, batting helmet and bat. In order to advance to the next division level, the child needs to meet minimum requirements. If a child does not attend a skills assessment evaluation, he will not be part of the player draft and will be placed on a team at the lowest level based on age.

*New for 2016: Indoor Winter Clinics at Franklin Middle School gym will be held during February and March Only registered/paid players will be invited by email to take part in the scheduled (to be determined) clinic sessions

Additional Information

Work bond is required \$100.00 per family (no work bond for girls softball or baseball ages 17-18)
