As required by Municipal Code Chapter 333.

## Requirements for Banners:

- (1) Applications shall be made to the Township Clerk's Office at least *30 days* prior to the intended day of display.
- (2) Banners shall announce functions or find-raising events for charitable, educational, civic or religious organizations within the Township of Franklin.
- (3) Banners may remain in place for no more than 14 days.
- (4) The dimensions of a banner may not exceed six feet in height or 16 feet in length, with a maximum area of 32 square feet.
- (5) The highest portion of the banner shall not exceed 25 feet.
- (6) The minimum clearance of banners above the finished grade level shall be 16 feet.
- (7) Banners shall not be lighted.
- (8) Banners shall be displayed at least 1,000 feet from any traffic signal.
- (9) Banners to be displayed across county/and or state roads shall be subject to any applicable standards and permit requirements of the County of Somerset and/or State of New Jersey, respectively.

### Additional Documentation to be submitted with Application:

- (1) Sketch of banner, including type, color, material and language.
- (2) Sketch of the proposed location of the banner.
- (3) Certificate of Insurance from an A-rated insurance company setting forth the Township of Franklin as a named insured under the policy, with liability insurance limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- (4) Indemnification Agreement indemnifying and holding the Township of Franklin harmless from any claims arising therefrom.
