FHS 142 kids, one child did good academically and he just received a 4 year scholarship to go to college. He had previously had anger issues. Sophomores are starting to understand the importance of academics.

Davenport started girls circle at FMS with 6 girls. Curriculum with activities however, students need counseling because of the issues that they bring to the group.
