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Current -- ARTICLE III – MISSION

Vision

The Franklin Township Municipal Alliance envisions a community that promotes health and wellness and is free of the misuse and abuse of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs.

Mission

The purpose of the Franklin Township Municipal Alliance is to encourage the community to practice healthy, drug-free living and to provide education and resources on substance abuse prevention. The Alliance will continue the ongoing process of community involvement, collaborations, education, public awareness activities, sharing resources, and delivery of quality programs. Alliance will address the symptoms and root cause of alcohol, tobacco and drug abuse problems in the community in relation to preventive measures and law enforcement procedures. We will strive to implement programs and activities that foster positive communication, strong families and substance abuse free lives.

In carrying out its mission the Alliance shall:

1. Organize and coordinate efforts with the Franklin Township Public Schools, Clergy, Law Enforcement, Municipal recreation, Health and Social Services, the Judicial System, Business Groups and Other Community Services Organizations for the purpose of reducing tobacco use, alcoholism and drug abuse.
2. In cooperation with the Franklin Township Public Schools: provide comprehensive and effective alcohol and drug abuse prevention education programs for students grades K-12, parent awareness and training education programs for parents and other adult community members and referral to intervention services for students and/or their families involved with the use of tobacco and the abuse of alcohol and/or drugs.
3. In cooperation with the Municipal Youth Services Commission, assist with efforts to provide the youth of the community wholesome tobacco/alcohol/drug-free recreational opportunities.
4. Determine, through a community-based needs assessment, the scope and depth of the substance abuse problem and identify treatment/referral services currently available and make recommendations to address the gaps in services.
