• Grant for Green Infrastructure and Trail Development at Naaman Williams Park

- Tara delivered a presentation to review of the findings from the assessment on September 19th.
- Tara will consult with Dr. Obropta of Rutgers University during a site visit on October 25, 2023. Dr. Obropta has a background in green infrastructure and will offer design recommendations for the site.
- During the committee's prior meetings and activities in the park, feedback from park path users agree with the current assessments and overall concepts to improve drainage.
 - Additional requests were to clear snow from the path after winter storms, as ice is likely to form where the water collects, and access to other safe spaces for physical activity are limited.
- o Tara will prepare for public engagement sessions for November & December.

The township has a grant through the Environmental Commission for a micromobility study and plan, based on the health assessment. The study would identify whether an e-micromobility mode can be support trips to nearby transit hubs via trails where bicycles are permitted.
