Originally approved for \$400,000,000 through sales tax in 2009. Will lose matching funds for Agricultural/farm and open space land preservation deals.

- f) Chase reported the Cable TV Committee would like to film OSAC for Volunteer Practice. Committee expressed concerns of having an unofficial document, of an official meeting. LaCorte moved; Moon seconded motion not to allow practice filming of meeting. Motion Passes
- g) Trail Easement for Memorial Forest John and Fran plan to meet with Mr. Kalogridis to discuss a possible donation of a trail easement thorough his property to connect a bike path from Memorial Forest to existing bike trail on Elizabeth Ave.

h) Scalzone Property

Fran reported that Scalzone property was preserved by Franklin Twp funds. Joanne Begrin, Franklin Twp. Grants Coordinator, will seek 50% reimbursement of the purchase and due diligence costs from NJ Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres program local assistance grants program.

8. Old Business

a. Healey reported The historic portion of the study will be completed by end of January. In addition the recreation study will be presented to council for review and adoption, late February or early March in a public session.

- b. Connell reported previously approved \$6,000 in funds in 2008 for annual Audubon society walks have been exhausted. The committee was requested to approve a new fund of \$6,000.00 for future walks. The committee was reminded that the Audubon society, in addition to the walks, is a valuable partner in managing the Negri Nepoti, and Griggstown grass land areas. Schmidt moved Williams seconded motion to approve funds.
- c. The trails maps are running out and need to be reprinted. The committee approves but a discussion ensued regarding having sponsors, and advertising the assets of Franklin Township on the maps. A request was made to reach out to the Chamber of Commerce and other partners to better utilize the branding potential of the maps.

Connell will prepare several pricing options of the maps for February meeting to discuss.
