IS MY PROPERTY IN A FLOOD ZONE?

NOTICE TO: Lending institutions, real estate and insurance agents, and the general public

SUBJECT: Flood Insurance Rate Map Zone Information

As a public service, the Township of Franklin will provide you with the following information upon request:

- Whether a property is in or out of the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) as shown on the current Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) of the Township.
- Additional flood insurance data for a site, such as the FIRM zone and the base flood elevation or depth, if shown on the FIRM.
- We have a handout on the flood insurance purchase requirement that can help people who need a mortgage or loan for a property in the SFHA.
- We have copies of completed FEMA Elevation Certificates for buildings built in the floodplain since 1991.

If you would like to make an inquiry, please tell us the street address and, if available, the lot and block number. We are open 7:30 to 4:30, Monday through Friday. Call us at (732) 873-2500, extension 6230 or drop by the Engineering Department in Town Hall. Anyone in the office can provide the needed information. There is no charge for general inquiries. A signed certificate detailing the FIRM information is available from the Engineering Department for a fifteen (\$15.00) dollar fee.
