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NOTICE TO BIDDERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be opened in the Municipal Building, Township of Franklin, Somerset County, 475 DeMott Lane, Somerset, New Jersey, at 11:00 a.m. prevailing time on April 15, 2014 for the following specifications:

**B14-6ENG
ROAD RESURFACING—NEW BRUNSWICK ROAD
(Initial notice incorrectly labled "Clyde Road Area")**

Specifications and bid blanks may be reviewed and obtained in Purchasing at the Municipal Building. There is a \$25 non-refundable charge for each set of plans and specifications.

Bids must be on the Proposal sheets furnished in the Specifications and enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to the Purchasing Administrator of the Township of Franklin, 475 DeMott Lane, Somerset, NJ 08873. The name of the bidder and the name of the project must be plainly marked on the envelope.

Bid security IS required and must be submitted with the bid. It must not be less than ten (10%) of the total bid price. Such bid security may be in the form of a bid bond, cashier's check or certified check, but in any event it is not to exceed \$20,000. Also required is a Certificate from a Surety Company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey, stating that it will provide the contractor with a bond guaranteeing the faithful performance of the contract. The successful bidder shall provide performance bond and payment bond each for 10 percent of the award of contract and a maintenance bond for one year.

Attention is called to the Federal requirements regarding employment non-discrimination. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27, as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act. All bidders shall submit a Disclosure of Ownership statement in compliance with PL 1977, C. 33. The successful bidder shall be required to comply with all the requirements of the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act 150, (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 et seq and N.J.S.A. 34:1B5.1). The successful bidder and subcontractors shall comply with P.L. 2004, c. 57 and submit Business Registration Certificates before the award of contract.
