PROGRAM ACTIVITIES:

- Photography: Learn some basic tips and tricks for landscape photography courtesy of David Hartz Photography. Don't forget to bring your camera!
- Geocaching: GPS device or GPS enabled mobile required
- Hooping: Learn the benefits of hula hooping by a skilled Hooper. A limited number of hoops will be available courtesy of Wikihoops. Hiking while hooping – you can do it!
- Hiking: Hike the trails with your pet (leash required). Guided tour begins at 9:30a.m.
- History: Learn about the history of Griggstown Native Grassland Preserve, and why grasslands are crucial to nature & the environment.

INFORMATIONAL DISPLAY TABLE:

- Photograph Display: Photographs of the Franklin Township Trails (many taken by contestants of the Franklin Township Trails photography contest).
- Outdoors Safety: Learn how to protect yourself from the dangers of hiking (ticks, dehydration, poison ivy, etc.) so that your hike is an enjoyable experience.
- Maps: Free Franklin Township Trail maps.
- Checklists: Free bird and butterfly checklist.
- Cups of water will be available at the display table.

Bring binoculars if you have them, and sturdy footwear is recommended. We also recommend that hikers carry bottled water and a snack, and wear insect repellent.
