If it is deemed allowable legal the recommendation would be to support the salary only from the OSTF and not fringe benefits. G. Randolph seconded. All members in Favor. Motion passes.

The issue with allowing permitted hunters through the Twp. Program is that there is no access or parking as the properties are landlocked.
