

Franklin Township OPEN SPACE PROGRAM CONTINUES NATURE WALKS

Explore wilderness right in the heart of Franklin Township!







The Township's open space program will, for the 12th consecutive year, sponsor guided nature walks on Township open space parcels. The 2016 walks began in March and continue through Spring, Summer and Fall months. *The walks are free to the public.* The walks are along easy terrain and are great for kids. Bring binoculars, if you have them, and waterproof footwear.

While Franklin Township is located in one of the most densely populated regions of the country, it claims over 9,000 acres of preserved land (1/3 of the township's land mass) and this area provides key habitat for unique species of plants and animals.

The walks will be led by NJ Audubon naturalists.

Butler Road Natural Area Hike Sunday, September 18 9:00am to 11:00am

Meet at the parking lot located at 134 Butler Road

Bunker Hill Natural Area Sunday, October 23 9:00am to 11:00am

Meet at the parking lot located at 50 Bunker Hill Road
